The Brueder Schlau Group (Brüder Schlau GmbH & Co. KG), based in Porta Westfalica, is one of the leading retail and wholesale companies for interior design. With its strong brands Hammer, Hometrend and Schlau, the Group aims to support the wishes and needs of its wholesale and retail customers. As part of an agency change, the previous online presences brueder-schlau.de, hammer-heimtex.de, hometrend.de and schlau-grosshandel.de will be converted to a new, improved infrastructure and software.

The foundation: Amazon Web Services

By June 2017, the current infrastructure was rebuilt entirely in the first step, and a new platform was created on Amazon Web Services. The developers from Hanover advise and support the retailer in setting up the AWS infrastructure with VPC, VPN, EC2, CloudFront, RDS and S3. Furthermore, tecRacer's cloud consultants design the ETL process infrastructure and set it up. Hosting and support for the SAP Hybris and Adobe AEM systems were required for the Groups' web presence and the intranet. In addition, an e-commerce shop for wholesale customers was to be created. All went live on 3 July 2017 at www.schlau-grosshandel.de. Furthermore, Hammer's e-commerce shop for the retail distribution channel is planned for this year.

Hosting, Support, Monitoring

tecRacer advises and supports the Brueder Schlau Group in de-platforming an existing application to the AWS platform and building the associated infrastructure. "The big challenge is that the previous infrastructure has to remain in place until the changeover to the new environment is complete,"
